1. B. Volkova welcomes all WIC members.

 - Titli Sahni requests a clarification of the role of the President in the Membership Committee. K. Ratra reads out the corresponding section of the WIC Constitution
 - S. A. (Gugu) Singh states that committees have to fulfill their duties by themselves. The President, who has delegated certain tasks to committees, has a supervisory function, but is not directly involved, e.g. in selecting new members.
 - Furthermore, she criticizes the publication of the Gala Night in an Indian newspaper in connection with a religious festival as already given to the Executive Committee in written form
