THE E.U. EXPERIENCE OF REGIONAL INTEGRATION

H.E. Ambassodor Daniele Smadja, Head of Delegation of the European Commisssion to India, Bhutan and Nepal, will speak to us about her experiences of representing Europe in India.

The EU Experience of Regional Integration

Before the creation of the European Union, the European continent had long witnessed frequent and bloody ware between neighbours, which culminated in the Second World War. Against he backdrop of the human suffering stemming from this devastating war, as well as the need for reconciliation and reconstruction, the idea of a united Europe through the pooling of its strategic resources was born in the early fifties. The European Coal and Steel Community began to unite European countries economically and politically in order to secure lasting peace. Starting from six funding Member States and from Coal and Steel, the Community soon expanded in areas and in number and continued over more than 50 years - the latest enlargement being mainly the result of the fall of the Berlin wall when the Europeans become a Union of 27 Member States. Since the European Union Member States came closer and decided to have common rules in such key areas as trade, competition currency, agriculture, and environment as well as consumer policy or immigration to name but a few, this unique process of regional integration has brought about peace and stability for more than 470 million citizens. A proactive EU regional policy aiming at reducing internal disparities of development within and between Member States has also played a key role in securing inclusive growth and stability and other financial opportunities to improve infrastructures or the environment as well. The effects of EU membership are also visible for people outside the EU such as Indian tourists who can enjoy the Schengen area or the single currency - the Euro - when they travel from one EU Member State to another without control at the internal border.
