Ashish N Soni is known for his sharply refined, intuitive & deceptively simple sense of aesthetics. He interned with the guru of fashion, Rohit Bal, while studying at the National Institute of Fashion Technology in Delhi.

He launched his own label, Ashish Soni, in 1992 and began retailing from the then very popular store, Mutiny and expanded the label to retail in Ffolio, Bangalore and Ensemble, Mumbai. His signature pieces are mostly handcrafted & characterized by extreme simplicity. Perfect finishing & impeccable garment construction create stunningly minimal yet dramatic garments. Attention to detail derived from a menswear background remains the brands forte. With design as his primary focus, embellishments are subsidiary & used with great restraint in the brands



offerings, most of which are immaculately tailored & individually hand-finished.

Ashish became a founding member of the Fashion Design Council of India in 1998 and played a strategic role in pioneering its creation. His experimentation with Indian fabrics used in contemporary fashion by blending & infusing them with unusual textures & treatments have won him many accolades as an Indian designer who speaks a global language.

He was the first designer to be officially invited to hold a runway show at Olympus Fashion Week in New York. At his debut show in New York, he was hailed as "one of New York's new discoveries" by International Herald Tribune's Suzy Menkes. In 2017, Ashish Soni completed 25 years in the world of fashion and celebrated his journey with "Welcome to my World" at The Lodhi Hotel, New Delhi.
